Tapestry needle

22 sts and 30 rows $=4^{\prime \prime}$ in St st TO SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE

## SHAWL

Using provisional cast-on, cast on 8 sts.
Set-Up Rows: Row 1 (WS): K3, pm, k2tog, pm, k3 7 sts.
Row 2 (RS): K3, yo, sm, k1, sm, yo, k3-9 sts.
Row 3: K3, p1, sm, k1, sm, p1, k3.
Row 4: K3, yo, k1, yo, sm, k1, sm, yo, k1, yo, k3-13 sts.
Row 5: K3, p3, sm, k1, sm, p3, k3.
Row 6: (K3, yo) twice, sm, k1, sm, (yo, k3) twice - 17 sts.
Row 7: K3, p5, sm, k1, sm, p5, k3.
Row 8: K3, yo, k1, yo, sl 1, k2tog, psso, yo, k1, yo, sm, k1, sm, yo, k1, yo, sl 1, k2tog, psso, yo, k1, yo, k3-21 sts.
Row 9: $\mathrm{k} 3, \mathrm{p} 3, \mathrm{k} 1, \mathrm{p} 3, \mathrm{sm}, \mathrm{k} 1, \mathrm{sm}, \mathrm{p} 3, \mathrm{k} 1, \mathrm{p} 3, \mathrm{k} 3$.
Row 10: K 3 , yo, k3, p1, k3, yo, sm, k1, sm, yo, k3, p1, k3, yo, k3-25 sts.
Pattern Stitch: Row 1 (WS): K3, p4, * k1, p3, rep from * to 1 st before marker, $\mathrm{p} 1, \mathrm{sm}, \mathrm{k} 1, \mathrm{sm}, \mathrm{p} 4,{ }^{* *} \mathrm{k} 1$, p3, rep from ** to last 4 sts, end p1, k3.
Row 2 (RS): K3, yo, k1, * yo, sl 1, k2tog, psso, yo, k1, rep from * to marker, yo, sm, k1, sm, yo, k1, ${ }^{* *}$ yo, sl 1, k2tog, psso, yo, k1, rep from ** to last 3 sts, end yo, k3-4 sts inc'd.
Row 3: K3, * p3, k1, rep from * to 3 sts before marker, p3, sm, k1, sm, p3, ** k1, p3, rep from ** to last 3 sts, end k3.
Row 4: $K 3, y o, k 3,{ }^{*} p 1, k 3$, rep from * to 3 sts before marker, k3, yo, sm, k1, sm, yo, k3, ** p1, k3, rep from * to last 3 sts, end yo, k3-4 sts inc'd.
Rep the last 4 rows 29 times more, then work Rows 1 - 3 once more, end on WS - 261 sts ( 130 sts on each side of markers).
Edging: Row 1 (RS): K3, yo, k2tog, * yo, k3, yo, k1, sl 1, k2tog, psso, k1, rep from * to 5 sts before marker, yo, k3, yo, SSK, yo, sm, k1, sm, yo, k2tog, ** yo, k3, yo, k1, sl 1, k2tog, psso, k1, rep from ${ }^{* *}$ to last 8 sts, end yo, k3, yo, SSK, yo, k3-4 sts inc'd.


Rows 2, 4, 6 and 8 (WS): K3, purl to marker, sm, k1, sm, purl to last 3 sts, end k3.
Row 3 (RS): K3, yo, k2tog, k2, * yo, k1, yo, k2, sl 1, k2tog, psso, k2, rep from * to 5 sts before marker, yo, k1, yo, k2, SSK, yo, sm, k1, sm, yo, k2tog, k2, ** yo, k1, yo, k2, sl 1, k2tog, psso, k2, rep from ** to last 8 sts, end yo, k1, yo, k2, SSK, yo, k3.
Row 5 (RS): k3, yo, k1, k2tog, k2, * yo, k1, yo, k2, sl 1, k2tog, psso, k2, rep from * to 6 sts before marker, yo, k1, yo, k2, k2tog, k1, yo, sm, k1, sm, yo, k1, k2tog, k2,
** yo, k1, yo, k2, sl 1, k2tog, psso, k2, rep from ** to last 9 sts, end yo, k1, yo, k2, SSK, k1, yo, k3.
Row 7 (RS): K3, yo, k2, k2tog, k2, * yo, k1, yo, k2, sl 1, k2tog, psso, k2, rep from * to 7 sts before marker, yo, k1, yo, k2, SSK, k2, yo, sm, k1, sm, yo, k2, k2tog, ** yo, k1, yo, k2, sl 1, k2tog, psso, k2, rep from * to last 10 sts, end yo, k1, yo, k2, SSK, k2, yo, k3.
Rep Rows 1 - 8 four times more - 341 sts.
Next Row: K3, purl to marker, sm, k1, sm, purl to last 3 sts, end k3. Rep the last row 5 times more. Bind off using Sewn Bind Off.

## FINISHING

Carefully unpick provisional cast on, placing 4 sts on one end of needle, and 4 sts on the other end. Graft sts together using kitchener st. Block as desired.

## ABBREVIATIONS \& TERMS

## Knit

beg: beginning
CC: contrasting color
cdd (centered double decrease): Slip 2 together,
knit 1 , pass the 2 slipped stitches over.
cn: cable needle
cont: continue
dec: decrease
dpn: double pointed needles
est: established
inc: increase
K: knit
k tbl: knit through the back loop(s)
k2tog: Knit 2 stitches together
k3tog: Knit 3 stitches together
LH: left hand
MC: main color
M1: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).
M1L: Work as for M1.
M1p: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).
M1pL: Work as for M1p.
M1pR: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).
M1R: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).
p: purl
p tbl: purl through the back loop(s)
pat(s): pattern(s)
pm: place marker
psso: pass slip stitch over knit stitch
p2tog: purl 2 stitches together
p2sso: pass 2 slip stitches over knit stitch
p3tog: purl 3 stitches together
rem: remaining
rep: repeat
RH: right hand
rnd(s): round(s)
RS: right side
sl: slip
sm: slip marker

SSK: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.
SSP: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, transfer these 2 stitches back to left hand needle, purl 2 together through the back loops.
st(s): stitch(es)
TBL: through back loop(s)
tog: together
WS: wrong side
wyib: with yarn in back
wyif: with yarn in front
yo: yarn over
end on WS: end having just completed a Wrong Side row.
end on RS: end having just completed a Right Side row
STOCKINETTE ST (St st): Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.
Reverse St st (Rev St st): Purl 1 row, knit 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The purl side is the right side of the work. Purl EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.
GARTER ST: Knit EVERY row when working on straight needles. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working on a circular needle.

ch: chain
dc: double crochet
hdc: half double crochet
sc: single crochet
sl st: slip stitch
sp: space
tr: treble
